As our Lord was pleased to be born of the lineage of Kings with good reason did he favour the three Kings by appearing to them

This is what happened when he was born to Holy Mary in Bethlehem and thirteen days after He appeared to the three Kings as each one of them had the wisdom to recognise in his star that he was God and King, and so from afar they came to behold him,

even from the isles of Saba and of Tarsus, from across the sea and from Arabia, of mighty hosts passing through many lands And even though they were far off He who has power over all things made them arrive at Bethlehem in no time at all.
