## <u>Correction to Responsibility and Atonement</u>

I cited here what I claimed to be a declaration of the First Council of Lyons (AD 1245) that those who died without penitence in mortal sin would be 'crucified forever in the fires of eternal Hell'. This attribution was an error of mine. That Council made no dogmatic declarations. The passage cited was from a letter of the then Pope Innocent 1V.
