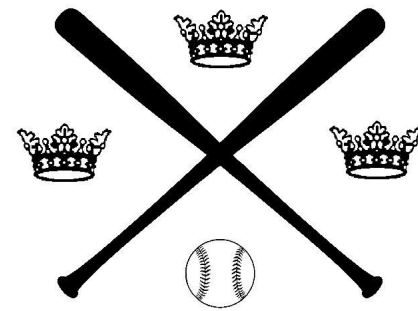

How do we get to the games?
