

Beata Javorcik is Professor of Economics at the University of Oxford and a Fellow of All Souls College. She is also a Programme Director at the Centre for Economic Policy Research in London and a member of the Executive Committee of the Royal Economic Society. Her research interests focus on determinants and consequences of inflows of foreign direct investment, links between exporting and the gender wage gap, and export financing.

Prior to coming to Oxford, Professor Javorcik worked at the World Bank in Washington DC where she was involved in research activities, lending operations and provision of policy advice to developing countries in Central and Eastern Europe, Latin America and Asia.

Professor Javorcik has published in the *American Economic Review*, *Journal of the European Economic Association*, *Review of Economics and Statistics*, *Economic Journal*, *European Economic Review*, *Journal of International Economics* and *Journal of Development Economics*. She holds a Ph.D. in Economics from Yale University and a B.A. from the University of Rochester. At Oxford, she has taught at the undergraduate and graduate level and has been involved in a business education program.
