Notice to Individual Members 2010

The subscription to the Society is **£20.00** or **US\$40.00**, and is now due. If you decide not to renew your subscription, please inform the Membership Secretary at once.

PAYMENT can be made by debit/credit card, or cheque (excluding Eurocheque) or postal order made out to 'Early English Text Society'. All payment forms with relevant card details or payment should be sent by post as soon as possible to the MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY. The dollar rate includes a sum to cover bank charges for the handling of foreign cheques. Any American member who prefers to do so may pay in sterling; the amount due is £20.00. All overseas members who pay in sterling should ensure that £20.00 reaches the Society; **all bank charges must be carried by the member**. Payments may also be made by banker's order; please contact the Membership Secretary for details. European members may otherwise pay by international postal order or by bank sterling draft. Members from the Irish Republic should pay in sterling. Please ensure that all payments by banker's order give the full correct name. If paying by debit/credit card, please include the security code as payments cannot now be processed without it.

BOOKS AGAINST SUBSCRIPTION Members will normally receive the issues for 2010 against their year's subscription. Alternatively, individual members may select from the Society's List of Publications, in place of one or both of the annual issues, past volumes from the Original, Extra or Supplementary Series. The value of such volumes (AT FULL LIST PRICES) allowed against one annual subscription is £30.00, the substitution value of each of the 2009 entitlement volumes being £15.00. Members who wish to take advantage of this substitution should complete the appropriate section of the Payment Form, and return it to the Membership Secretary **not later than 31st March 2010**. If the cost of books chosen for substitution exceeds these sums, members may add the excess (less 30%) to their subscription payment; a separate cheque or card payment is not necessary.

BOOKS AT DISCOUNT The discount to individual members is 30%. Volumes the entire cost of which is to be paid at the discount rate should be ordered on the Books at Discount form. **An invoice will be sent by the publisher. This must be paid before the books can be despatched.**

DATA PROTECTION ACT The Society is not required to register under the terms of the 1998 Data Protection Act. Members are informed that their names, titles and addresses are stored on computer files. This helps with administration and the preparation of labels for mailings. The list is used for EETS purposes only, and will not be supplied to any other organisation. However, any member objecting to his or her name and address being stored in this way should contact the Membership Secretary.
