London and Oxford, UK

The Nuffield College Centre for Applied Macro Policy (NuCamp) and the Center for Applied Economics and Policy Research (CAEPR) at Indiana University invite submissions to the inaugural Oxford-Indiana Macroeconomic Policy Conference. The conference will be held over two days, on Monday 9th July 2018 at the Nuffield Foundation in London and on Tuesday 10th July 2018 at St John's College in Oxford. We welcome submissions of empirical and theoretical papers in all areas of applied macroeconomic policy.

Presenters will be offered accommodation and meals for the duration of the conference in Oxford and London, and transportation from London to Oxford on Monday evening. We have a limited budget available for presenters unable to fund their own travel expenses.
