Confidentiality

The research data will be kept in a secure location (or password protected and encrypted) and only the researcher will have access to the data. The data will be stored indefinitely for use in this and in other studies that seek to understand the genetics of human traits.

Benefits

There are no direct benefits for your child's participation in this project.

Compensation

There will be no compensation for participation in this project.
