- Banting Postdoctoral Fellowships

No restrictions on nationality if held at an eligible Canadian institution. Canadians and permanent residents of Canada can hold the fellowship at institutions outside of Canada. Deadline 17 September 2024.
- PIMS Postdoctoral Fellowships

Held at PIMS-member universities (across western Canada and University of Washington). Application deadlines are generally in November and advertised on MathJobs. Applicants apply to the host university and a long-list is created of those with sponsorship from an eligible supervisor. The final ranking and selection is done by PIMS.
- Sverker Lerheden fellowship  
Two + one year fellowships for postdoctoral studies in mathematics at Stockholm University. Deadline in November.

- Postdoctoral scholarship from the Knut and Alice Wallenberg foundation  
For candidates with a PhD from outside Sweden are eligible for a two-year fellowship in mathematics. Application should be carried out by a researcher at a Swedish university. Deadline in October.

Four-year starting grants for conducting research at a Swedish university. The grantee will during the grant period be employed at a Swedish university (with or without the possibility for tenure). Deadline April.
